Informações essenciais

Pré-requisitos

Participants must have completed the MOB Boat Basic Course. Personnel who have not served in an emergency preparedness role and have not completed an emergency preparedness course or equivalent training within the last 5 years must complete the basic course again.

Para quem é?

Crew members on fixed or floating offshore installations who are assigned to operate a large MOB boat in accordance with Offshore Norge guidelines.

Avaliação

Participants are assessed throughout all practical training. If a participant does not pass the practical training, the reason for the assessment outcome will be provided. Participants who do not demonstrate achievement of the required competence objectives will not successfully complete the course.

Certificação

Upon successful completion, you will receive a certificate valid for 2 years.

Course content

• MOB Boat Technical

Technical aspects of the MOB boat and associated equipment.

• Navigation

Navigation relevant to MOB boat operations.

• Search and Rescue

Search methods, recovery of persons from the water and rescue operations.

• Manoeuvring

Practical manoeuvring and operation of the MOB boat.

• Communication

Communication during MOB boat and search and rescue operations.

• Night Operations

Practical MOB boat operation and manoeuvring in darkness.
