Essential Information

Prerequisites

Basic Safety Training and a valid VHF/SRC certificate.

Who is it for?

Personnel who are required to perform the function of a free-fall lifeboat coxswain.

Assessment

Participants are assessed throughout all practical training. Participants who do not pass the practical training will be provided with the reason for the assessment outcome. At the end of the course, participants must complete a theoretical test. Participants who do not meet the competence objectives will not successfully complete the course.

Certification

Upon successful completion you will receive a certificate valid for 2 years

Course content

• Emergency Preparedness

Emergency response organisation, command structure and reactions during emergency situations.

• Lifeboat Fundamentals

Basic introduction to the free-fall lifeboat and its use during evacuation.

• Mustering and Evacuation

Mustering, preparation of the lifeboat, embarkation and evacuation procedures.

• Alternative Evacuation Means

Introduction to alternative evacuation means, including liferafts and evacuation chutes.

Key Learning Objectives

01 L01 – Describe the organisation and purpose of emergency preparedness on an offshore installation.

02 L02 – Prepare a free-fall lifeboat for evacuation.

03 L03 – Organise and lead mustering and embarkation into the lifeboat.

04 L04 – Communicate by radio, internally in the lifeboat and with the emergency response organisation.

05 L05 – Launch the lifeboat from the offshore installation and navigate it to a safe area.

07 L07 – Operate emergency systems and equipment appropriate to different conditions onboard the lifeboat.

06 L06 – Manoeuvre the lifeboat and manage conditions for persons remaining onboard at sea.

08 L08 – Describe launching and safe evacuation using alternative evacuation means, including liferafts and evacuation chutes.
