The course refreshes and maintains the knowledge and practical skills required for safe work and emergency response on offshore installations, including risk awareness, first aid, helicopter evacuation, fire prevention, evacuation and sea survival. The course is available as standard classroom/practical training or as a blended option combining e-learning with practical training.

Essential Information

Prerequisites

Participants must have completed Basic Safety and Emergency Preparedness Training. For the blended option, participants must also complete the required e-learning before attending the practical training.

Who is it for?

Personnel who are required to stay or work on installations on the Norwegian Continental Shelf and need to renew their Basic Safety and Emergency Preparedness Training.

Assessment

Participants are assessed throughout all practical training. If a participant does not successfully complete the practical training, the reason for the assessment outcome will be provided. Water familiarisation exercises are mandatory in accordance with Offshore Norge guidelines.

Certification

Upon successful completion you will receive a certificate valid for 4 years

Course content

• Risk Awareness and Barriers

Offshore risk factors, barrier principles and individual contributions to safe operations.

• Helicopter Evacuation

Practical emergency evacuation from a helicopter or helicopter simulator.

• Sea Survival

Practical survival techniques, including use of a survival suit in the water and rough sea conditions.

• First Aid

Practical life-saving first aid during offshore emergency situations.

• Evacuation Methods

Use of evacuation chutes, liferafts and other relevant offshore evacuation equipment.

• Fire Protection

Fire prevention and practical extinguishing of incipient fires.
