Pré-requisitos

Participants must have completed: Basic Safety Training VHF/SRC Certificate

Para quem é?

Personnel who are required to perform the function of a free-fall lifeboat coxswain.

Avaliação

Participants are assessed throughout all practical training. If a participant does not successfully complete the practical training, the reason for the assessment outcome will be provided. At the end of the course, participants must complete a theoretical test. Participants who do not demonstrate achievement of the required competence objectives will not successfully complete the course.

Course content

• Emergency Preparedness

Emergency response organisation, command structure and reactions during emergency situations.

• Mustering and Evacuation

Mustering, preparation of the lifeboat, embarkation and evacuation procedures.

• Communication

Radio communication, internal lifeboat communication and communication with emergency response personnel.

• Alternative Evacuation Means

Alternative evacuation methods, including liferafts and evacuation chutes.

• Lifeboat Fundamentals

Basic introduction to free-fall lifeboats and their use during evacuation.

• Launching and Manoeuvring

Launching the free-fall lifeboat and manoeuvring it to a safe area.

• Emergency Systems and Equipment

Equipment Use of emergency systems and equipment under different conditions onboard the lifeboat.

Key Learning Objectives

01 L01 – Describe the organisation and purpose of emergency preparedness on an offshore installation.

02 L02 – Prepare a free-fall lifeboat for evacuation.



03 L03 – Organise and lead mustering and embarkation into the lifeboat.

05 L05 – Launch the lifeboat from the offshore installation and navigate it to a safe area.

07 L07 – Operate emergency systems and equipment appropriate to different conditions onboard the lifeboat.

04 L04 – Communicate by radio, internally in the lifeboat and with the emergency response organisation.

06 L06 – Manoeuvre the lifeboat and manage conditions for persons remaining onboard at sea.

08 L08 – Describe launching and safe evacuation using alternative evacuation means, including liferafts and evacuation chutes.
