The course refreshes and maintains the knowledge and practical skills required to perform the function of a free-fall lifeboat coxswain, including preparation, mustering, embarkation, launching, manoeuvring, communication and use of emergency systems and equipment.

Essential Information

Prerequisites

Participants must have completed: Basic Safety Training Lifeboat Coxswain Basic Course, or Proficiency in Survival Craft and Rescue Boats in accordance with STCW Table A-VI/2-1 Personnel who have not served in an emergency response role and have not completed emergency response training or equivalent training within the last 5 years must complete the basic course again.

Who is it for?

Personnel who perform the function of a free-fall lifeboat coxswain.

Assessment

Participants are assessed throughout all practical training. If a participant does not successfully complete the practical training, the reason for the assessment outcome will be provided. Participants who do not demonstrate achievement of the required competence objectives will not successfully complete the course.

Certification

Upon successful completion, you will receive a certificate valid for 2 years.

Course content

• Mustering and Preparation

Mustering, preparation of the free-fall lifeboat and embarkation before evacuation.

• Communication

Radio communication, internal lifeboat communication and communication with emergency response personnel.

• Emergency Systems and Equipment

Use of emergency systems and equipment under different conditions onboard the lifeboat.

• Evacuation

Launching the free-fall lifeboat from the installation and navigating to a safe area.

• Manoeuvring

Practical manoeuvring and operation of the free-fall lifeboat after launching.

Key Learning Objectives

01 L01 – Prepare a free-fall lifeboat for evacuation.

02 L02 – Organise and lead mustering and embarkation into the lifeboat.

03 L03 – Communicate by radio, internally in the lifeboat and with the emergency response organisation.

05 L05 – Manoeuvre the lifeboat and manage conditions for persons remaining onboard.

04 L04 – Launch the lifeboat from the offshore installation and navigate it to a safe area.

06 L06 – Operate emergency systems and equipment appropriate to different conditions onboard the lifeboat.
