O curso atualiza o conhecimento, a compreensão e as habilidades práticas necessárias para comandar embarcações de sobrevivência e botes de resgate, exceto botes de resgate rápidos, e para manter a competência de acordo com a Tabela A-VI/2-1 da STCW.

Informações essenciais

Pré-requisitos

Participants must have previously completed the basic course in Proficiency in Survival Craft and Rescue Boats Other Than Fast Rescue Boats in accordance with STCW Table A-VI/2-1. Participants must provide documentation of a valid Certificate of Competency as a deck, engine or electro-technical officer, and a valid Certificate of Proficiency or course certificate in accordance with STCW Table A-VI/2-1, issued within the previous 5 years. If the competence has expired, participants must document at least 12 months of sea service. The sea service is calculated within the 5 years preceding the course start date.

Para quem é?

Personnel who require refresher training for operating survival craft and rescue boats other than fast rescue boats. This course does not qualify participants to operate fast rescue boats. Additional training is required for fast rescue boat operations.

Avaliação

Participants must pass a written test with a minimum score of 80%. The written assessment is designed so that the 80% pass mark meets the Norwegian Maritime Authority requirement for full achievement of the required competence. All required practical exercises must be completed. Participants are observed individually by the instructor during practical exercises. The instructor assesses whether the participant demonstrates the required knowledge, understanding and practical skills in accordance with the applicable minimum competence standards.

Certificação

Upon successful completion, you will receive a certificate valid for 5 years

Course content

- **Survival Craft and Rescue Boat Operations**

Taking charge of a survival craft or rescue boat during and after launching.

- **Engine Operation**

Operation of the engine fitted to a survival craft.

- **Survivor Management**

Management of survivors and survival craft following abandonment of the vessel.

- **First Aid**

Provision of first aid to survivors following evacuation or rescue.

- **Locating and Signalling Equipment**

Use of communication and signalling equipment, locating devices, light signals and smoke signals.
