- **Maritime Security Policy**  
Maritime security policies and principles relevant to shipboard operations.
- **Sensitive Information**  
Handling and protection of security-sensitive information.
- **Threat Identification and Response**  
Recognition of potential security threats and appropriate reporting and response actions.
- **Preparedness, Training and Drills**  
Security preparedness, training and exercises used to maintain shipboard security awareness.
