The course refreshes the knowledge and practical skills required to operate a MOB boat safely, including launching, recovery, manoeuvring, navigation, communication, search and rescue, and recovery of a person from the water.

Essential Information

Prerequisites

Participants must have completed the MOB Boat Basic Course. Personnel who have not served in an emergency response role and have not completed emergency response training or equivalent training within the last 5 years must complete the basic course again.

Who is it for?

Crew members on fixed or floating offshore installations who are assigned to MOB boat duties in accordance with Offshore Norge guidelines.

Assessment

Participants are assessed throughout all practical training. If a participant does not successfully complete the practical training, the reason for the assessment outcome will be provided.

Certification

Upon successful completion, you will receive a certificate valid for 2 years according to Offshore Norge guidelines.

Course content

- **MOB Boat Technical**

Technical aspects of the MOB boat and associated equipment.

- **Navigation**

Navigation relevant to MOB boat operations.

- **Search and Rescue**

Search methods, recovery of persons from the water and practical rescue operations.

- **Manoeuvring**

Practical manoeuvring and operation of the MOB boat.

- **Communication**

Communication during MOB boat and emergency response operations.
