



STCW Basic Safety Training for Fishermen Refresher

The course refreshes and maintains the knowledge, understanding and practical skills required in emergency response, survival, firefighting, first aid and personal safety for fishermen.

Essential Information

Prerequisites

Participants must previously have completed at least 40 hours of STCW-F Basic Safety Training for Fishermen.

Who is it for?

Fishermen engaged in commercial fishing from Norwegian boats or vessels, regardless of vessel size, who need to renew or update their safety training certificate.

Assessment

Participants must pass a written test with a minimum score of 80%. The written assessment is designed so that the 80% pass mark meets the Norwegian Maritime Authority requirement for full achievement of the required competence. All required practical exercises must be completed. Participants are observed individually by the instructor during practical exercises. The instructor assesses whether the participant demonstrates the required knowledge, understanding and practical skills in accordance with the applicable minimum competence standards.

Certification

Upon successful completion, you will receive a certificate recognized by NMA. Refresher training must be completed within 8 years, but not earlier than 5 years after the previous approved safety training. Thereafter, equivalent refresher training must be completed every 5–8 years following the most recent course. Fishermen who do not complete the refresher training within the required period must complete the Basic Safety Training for Fishermen again.

Course content

• Emergencies and Evacuation

Emergency situations, evacuation procedures and appropriate actions during onboard emergencies.

• Personal Survival Equipment

Use of personal lifesaving appliances and practical survival techniques.

• Breathing Apparatus

Practical use of breathing apparatus during firefighting and in smoke-filled environments.

• Survival Craft and Rescue Boats

Use and purpose of survival craft and rescue boats during emergency and abandonment situations.

• Fire Theory

Principles of fire, fire prevention and firefighting.

• First Aid

Basic first aid principles and immediate response to injury or illness onboard.

- **Personal Safety**

Personal safety responsibilities and safe behaviour while working onboard.
