



STCW Fast Rescue Craft (FRC) Refresher

The course refreshes the knowledge, understanding and practical skills required to operate a fast rescue boat and maintain competence in accordance with STCW Table A-VI/2-2.

Essential Information

Prerequisites

Participants must have completed training in Proficiency in Survival Craft and Rescue Boats Other Than Fast Rescue Boats in accordance with STCW Table A-VI/2-1, or hold a valid Certificate of Competency as a deck, engine or electro-technical officer. Participants must also have completed Fast Rescue Boat training in accordance with STCW Table A-VI/2-2. This must be documented by a valid Fast Rescue Boat course certificate or Certificate of Proficiency meeting the requirements of STCW Regulation VI/2, paragraph 2. If the Fast Rescue Boat competence has expired, participants must document at least 12 months of sea service while holding valid Fast Rescue Boat training or certification. The sea service is calculated within the 5 years preceding the course start date.

Who is it for?

Personnel who require refresher training for operating a fast rescue boat.

Assessment

Participants must pass a written test with a minimum score of 80%. The written assessment is designed so that the 80% pass mark meets the Norwegian Maritime Authority requirement for full achievement of the required competence. All required practical exercises must be completed. Participants are observed individually by the instructor during practical exercises. The instructor assesses whether the participant demonstrates the required knowledge, understanding and practical skills in accordance with the applicable minimum competence standards.

Certification

Upon successful completion, you will receive a certificate that this valid for 5 years.

• Fast Rescue Boat Construction

Construction, equipment, maintenance and repair of fast rescue boats.

• Launching Appliances

Launching appliances and associated equipment used during fast rescue boat operations.

• Launching and Recovery

Practical launching and recovery of a fast rescue boat.

• Manoeuvring

Practical manoeuvring of a fast rescue boat under operational conditions.

- **Search Operations**

Search methods and search patterns used during rescue operations.

- **Sea Rescue**

Practical rescue operations at sea using a fast rescue boat.
