The course refreshes the knowledge, understanding and practical skills required to provide medical care onboard ship and to maintain competence in accordance with STCW Table A-VI/4-2.

Essential Information

Prerequisites

Participants must provide documentation of a valid Certificate of Competency for deck officers or a valid course certificate in Medical Care in accordance with STCW Table A-VI/4-2. If the competence has expired, participants must document at least 12 months of sea service while holding a valid Certificate of Competency or valid course certificate. The sea service is calculated within the 5 years preceding the course start date.

Who is it for?

Seafarers who require refresher training for responsibility for medical care onboard ship. Medical Care training is mandatory as part of the education of deck officers.

Assessment

Participants must pass a written test with a minimum score of 80%. The written assessment is designed so that the 80% pass mark meets the Norwegian Maritime Authority requirement for full achievement of the required competence. All required practical exercises must be completed. Participants are observed individually by the instructor during practical exercises. The instructor assesses whether the participant demonstrates the required knowledge, understanding and skills in accordance with the applicable minimum competence standards.

Certification

Upon successful completion, you will receive a certificate valid for 5 years in accordance with STCW Table A-VI/4-2.

• Life-Saving First Aid and Medical Care

Life-saving first aid and medical treatment of sick or injured persons onboard.

• Illness and Disease

Recognition and management of common illnesses and medical conditions.

• Intravenous Fluid Therapy

Principles and practical considerations for intravenous fluid therapy.

• General Nursing

General nursing principles relevant to patient care onboard ship.

• Medicines and Medical Equipment

Appropriate use of medicines and medical equipment available onboard.

• Practical Medical Care

Practical exercises in assessment, treatment and care of patients onboard.
