The course provides participants with the knowledge, understanding and practical skills required to take charge of survival craft and rescue boats other than fast rescue boats and to demonstrate competence in accordance with STCW Table A-VI/2-1.

Essential Information

Prerequisites

Participants must have completed Basic Safety Training before attending the course.

Who is it for?

Personnel who are required to operate survival craft and rescue boats other than fast rescue boats. Additional training is required for personnel who will operate fast rescue boats.

Assessment

Participants must pass a written test with a minimum score of 80%. The written assessment is designed so that the 80% pass mark meets the Norwegian Maritime Authority requirement for full achievement of the required competence. All required practical exercises must be completed. Participants are observed individually by the instructor during practical exercises. The instructor assesses whether the participant demonstrates the required knowledge, understanding and skills in accordance with the applicable minimum competence standards.

Certification

Upon successful completion, you will receive a certificate valid for 5 years in accordance with STCW Table A-VI/2-1

Course content

• Survival Craft and Rescue Boat Operations

Taking charge of a survival craft or rescue boat during and after launching.

• Engine Operation

Operation of the engine fitted to a survival craft.

• Survivor Management

Management of survivors and survival craft following abandonment of the vessel.

• Locating and Signalling Equipment

Use of locating devices, communication and signalling equipment, light signals and smoke signals.

• First Aid

Provision of first aid to survivors following evacuation or rescue.
